



February 3rd: 4 hours strike for all the workers of italian plants of FIAT Group

Italian trade unions FIM, FIOM, UILM and FISMIC have decided to start an action in order to bring FIAT and Italian Government to take decisions for the re-launch of Italian automotive sector.

FIAT Group sectors (passenger cars, commercial and industrial vehicles, agriculture and construction equipment machineries, logistic and supply) are the most important part of Italian industry, both in terms of workforce, than in research and development. All those aspects must be improved. That is why we cannot accept plants closures and downsizings.

We ask to Italian government to speed up the start of talks about all the sectors, first of all the automobiles'one.

In the same way we wait for answers regarding the upgrade of welfare forms to this crisis times, improving the economic amounts offered to the workers.

FIAT must also change its industrial relations system, as a matter of fact, at the moment, they are only one-way communications of decision already taken elsewhere.

National trade unions ask to local sections and to all the workers'representatives to produce the maximum effort to achieve the best possible result for this first action.

Other initiatives will be decided depending from the timing of talks start and from the arguments that will be debated in the same talks.
