## TO ALL GM'EUROPE WORKERS

The National Fiom-Cgil leadership for Fiat Group wishes to show its encouragement and solidarity for your struggle in preserving plants and workforces.

GM management's will to shut down Antwerp reducing European employment level has deeply moved and filled with indignation Fiat's workers.

Here in Italy we're also struggling against similar kind of restructuring plans in the automotive field.

Fiat, as GM did, announced its will to shut down a plant too during 2011 (Termini Imerese's plant, located in Sicily, 1.658 employees who'll be directly dismissed and several hundreds of people from the related companies at serious risk).

In addition to that, CNH plant workers in Imola have been temporarily laid off ignoring whether production will be restarted or not.

To demonstrate against this "Fiat's industrial plan", Italian Unions have planned to strike on February 3rd at national level and with a large participation.

We do believe that a European mobilization of the workers against multinational companies' politics is needed in the same way you're currently struggling to preserve GM plants.

Solidarity among all workers and their commitment to struggle the current crisis, to avoid plant closures, to challenge all the policies aiming to reduce European employment level, their dedication to preserve people's rights and develop or re-invent the production system, should be considered as the foundations.

Fiat's workers are with you in this challenge.
