

April 30th, 2009, Fincantieri's workers demonstration

WE TOO ARE HERE TO DELIVER THE SHIP WE'VE CONSTRUCTED

The ship that today is delivered has a definite price: the hard work, the toil, the sacrifices of Fincantieri's workers.

This work, this toil, these sacrifices, haven't been recognised and respected by the company yet.

On April 1st, Fincantieri direction signed with some union organizations an agreement which hasn't been shared and accepted by the huge majority of the workers, by the absolute majority of the shop stewards (Rsu), by Fiom.

This agreement promises wage increases that won't be there and causes discrimination and injustices about salaries. It asks for unsustainable working performances, it doesn't deal positively in contracts, in health and safety, in work organization.

Above all, this agreement breaks the workers' right to decide about their bargaining; it's an imposition, carried out disregarding the simplest democracy rules.

We want to continue to construct large and beautiful ships, but we want respect and dignity for our work too. Until when this happens, until they want to impose agreements which shift inefficiency and unsolved problems onto workers, until everybody's toil and sacrifices won't have the right pay, we'll continue our struggle.
