



## **Co-operation with Valmet Automotive and Dimler**

- Valmet Automotive and Daimler AG announced last July that Valmet Automotive will manufacture the new Mercedes-Benz A-Class in Finland its plant in Uusikaupunki.
- Valmet Automotive has started the work for the project and the parties are expected to finalize the contract by end of 2012.
- More than 100,000 A-Class vehicles are planned to be manufactured by Valmet Automotive in Uusikaupunki, Finland from 2013 to 2016.



- Organizing is at very high level generally in Finland. About 80 % of all workforce is organized.
- In Metal Industry the big companies like Valmet Automotive it's more than 90 per cent.
- Precarius work is growing problem, but it is not verý big problem yet.
- According to our union's survey almost 90 % of our members are full time workers in permanent contracts. We estimated that about 1 % of workers in Metal industry are agency workers
