THE METALWORKERS IN ROME ON NOVEMBER 4TH

On November 4th in Rome there will be a large demonstration against work precariousness and for social rights.

Fiom calls on the metalworkers' participation because a new economic and social policy is necessary and because the struggle against precariousness has to be in the first place.

WE DEMAND:

- The abrogation of Law No. 30 which has caused an an unrestraint growth of work precariousness, in order to return to normal open-ended contracts.
- Laws and measures against wild work delocalization and outsourcing.
- The extension of the rights warranted by the Workers' Statute of Rights to all workplaces.
- The abrogation of the Boss-Fini Law which, by binding the permit to stay to the work contract, forces migrants in a condition of complete subordination to the companies.
- A struggle against news systems of illegal hiring of low wage work and concealed labour.
- The abrogation of the Moratti Law for a real right to study in public schools.
- A new social legislation warranting a decent life for all.

The metalworkers and the whole labour world suffer more and more from the damages caused by precariousness, which forces young people to uncertainty and low wages, which bears the risk of expelling older people from their workplaces without even a pension, which harms everybodys' health and safety.
